**G – Gardens are tilled, then carefully seeded.**



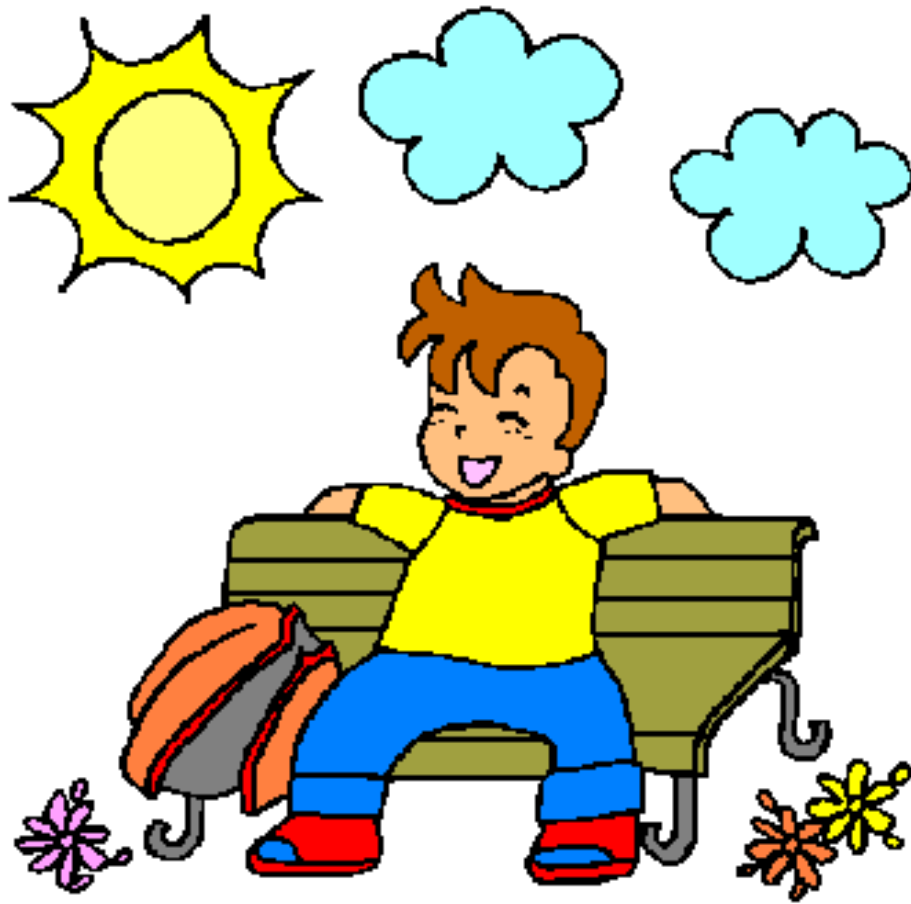


**H – Hoes and rakes are the tools that are needed.**
